With reference to your above application consent is hereby renewed for a period of **One year** from **01/07/2011 to 30/06/2012** subject to the fulfillment of the terms and conditions incorporated in the schedule of the consent letter No. 2681 dated: 17/02/95 and subsequent renewal issued to you by this office and additional conditions are mentioned below:-

Note:

- The products and production capacity mentioned above i.e. 100 Lacs Litre/Year for the manufacturing of Rectified Spirit of both the unit M/s. Gwalior Distillers Ltd. & M/s. Rairu Distilleries Ltd. shall be restricted to 150 KLD corresponding the maximum available present treatment capacity of effluent treatment plant. If at any point of time it is found that the industry has gone for distillation more than the restricted daily capacity of production, this permission shall be revoked without further intimation to the industry.*

2. *This renewal of consent under the Water Act is granted to the industry without prejudice to the criminal proceedings pending against the industry in the Court of Law. This renewal of consent in no way be taken as measures of proof that industry has not violated any pollution control laws at any time in the past. Hence, whatsoever may be the decision of Hon'ble Court shall be binding on the industry and this Board.*
3. *The total production of rectified spirit/country liquor either from grain or from molasses or from both shall not be more than the production capacity as limited by above condition.*

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

1. The industry shall improve their existing pollution control facilities and maintain the same properly so that the treated effluent could be maintained within the prescribed standards.
2. Industry shall fully comply protocol for utilization of distillery effluent for irrigation of agricultural crops, including safety protocol and monitoring requirements as suggested by Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) Delhi. Industry shall submit progress report regularly.
3. Industry shall comply recommendations of TFC and CREP charter circulated by Central Pollution Control Board.
4. Industry shall not use the treated effluent without proper dilution and no effluent should be stored in kachcha lagoons so that possibility of ground water contamination is reduced. Solar evaporation should be done only through pucca lagoons. Industry should also regularly monitor the ground water quality.
5. The drift salt generated during mist evaporation process should not fall beyond the boundary of pond, for this purpose the concentrated solids of ponds should be time to time removed and properly disposed off. Suitable curtains shall also be provided to prevent the spread of solid contents beyond the pond boundary.
6. Industry shall not discharge any effluent outside the factory premises in any circumstances and zero discharge condition shall be maintained.
7. The industry shall complete the lining of remaining lagoons [if any] which have to be used for storage of treated effluent. The industry shall not use any unlined lagoon for storage of industrial effluent.
8. The industry shall take temporary measures like dilution, incineration, solar evaporation, forced evaporation or industrial reuse etc. of treated effluent in order to stop any possibility of degradation of environment during the implementation of corrective measures, if required.
9. Industry shall take adequate precautionary measures before and during operation, maintenance and cleaning of pollution control equipment to avoid any accidental hazard.
10. Extensive tree plantation shall be carried out in open areas available within the factory premises around lagoons and good house keeping practices shall be adopted.



11. Solid waste would be generated in the form of ETP sludge (from grain based distillation) spent grain may be used as a cattle feed.
12. Industry shall install separate meter in accordance to Rule-3 of Water Cess Rules, 1978 for the measurement of water consumption in all the four categories as mentioned in the schedule-II of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977.
13. Industry shall submit environmental statement for the previous year ending 31st March on or before 30th September every year to the Board.
14. Industry shall make proper arrangement for the disposal of solid waste, also valid authorisation under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 shall be obtained from the Board.
15. The Board shall monitor the progress of time scheduled action plan and compliance of conditions from time to time and shall be free to forfeit the bank guarantee in part or whole. The Board reserves the right to release/forfeit the bank guarantee or permit extension of time period on merits of performance.
16. Industry shall comply with the conditions mentioned in earlier renewal of consent u/s 25/26 of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.
17. Industry shall comply with all the relevant acts/rules, directions, guidelines, notifications issued by MoEF/CPCB/MPPCB from time to time as required and, if applicable.
18. Industry shall submit a fresh application for next renewal of consent u/s 25/26 of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 180 days before the expiry of the date of this consent renewal letter.
The application shall be made in prescribed application form with consent renewal fee along with report of compliance of consent conditions mentioned in original consent letter and its subsequent consent renewal letter.
The consent renewal fee shall be payable as per latest gazettee notification dated: 07/10/09 in accordance with gross block mentioned.
19. Board reserves the right to amend, cancel or revoke this permission and renewal as and when the Board feels it necessary without any further correspondence.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

1. The industry shall improve their existing pollution control facilities and maintain the same properly so that the emission could be maintained within the prescribed standards.
2. Industry shall take adequate precautionary measures before and during operation, maintenance and cleaning of pollution control equipment to avoid any accidental hazard.
3. Extensive tree plantation shall be carried out in open areas available within the factory premises and good house keeping practices shall be adopted.
4. The pressure of the mist evaporators should be regulated to ensure that the effluent is not spread due to the wind pressure. The direction of throw of the mist shall be so adjusted that the droplets of effluent are properly arrested within pucca lagoons areas.
5. Industry shall submit environmental statement for the previous year ending 31st March on or before 30th September every year to the Board.
6. Industry shall provide necessary noise pollution control equipment like canopy/acoustic enclosures so that the noise level remains less than 75 dB (A) during day time and 70 dB (A) during night time.
7. Industry shall install safe spiral ladder and platform in boiler stack for stack monitoring.
8. Industry shall comply with the conditions mentioned in earlier renewal of consent order No. 2909 dated: 21/03/06 u/s 21 of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
9. Industry shall comply with all the relevant acts/rules, directions, guidelines, notifications issued by MoEF/CPCB/MPPCB from time to time as required and, if applicable.
10. Industry shall submit a fresh application for next renewal of consent u/s 21 of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 180 days before the expiry of the date of this consent renewal letter.
The application shall be made in prescribed application form with consent renewal fee along with report of compliance of consent conditions mentioned in original consent letter and its subsequent consent renewal letter.
The consent renewal fee shall be payable as per latest gazettee notification dated: 07/10/09 in accordance with gross block mentioned.
