ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

1. The industry shall improve their existing pollution control facilities properly and maintain the same and the treated effluent shall be maintained within the prescribed standards.
2. Industry shall fully comply with all the recommendations made in Nagda-Ratlam action plan finalised by CPCB vide their letter No. B-29012/23/93/PCI-I/9079, dt. 04/06/98.
3. Industry shall make arrangement for maximum utilisation of treated effluent within the premises for cooling tower makeup and gardening purpose etc. Industry shall not discharge the untreated effluent outside the factory premises in any circumstances.
4. Industry shall take adequate precautionary measures before and during operation, maintenance and cleaning of pollution control equipment to avoid any accidental hazard.
5. Extensive tree plantation shall be carried out in open areas available within the factory premises and good house keeping practices shall be maintained. The yearwise record shall be maintained for plantation and same shall be reported to the Board.
6. Industry shall make proper arrangement for the disposal of solid waste, also valid authorisation under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 shall be obtained from the Board.
7. Industry shall install separate meter in accordance to Rule-3 of Water Cess Rules, 1978 for the measurement of water consumption in all the four categories as mentioned in the schedule-II of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977.
8. Industry shall submit environmental statement for the previous year ending 31st March on or before 30th September every year to the Board.
9. The consent/renewal license fee deposited by the industry is liable for revision, if at any point of time it is found necessary.
10. Industry shall comply with all the relevant acts/rules, directions, guidelines issued by MoEF/CPCB/MPPCB from time to time as required and, if applicable
11. Industry shall submit a fresh application for next renewal of consent u/s 25/26 of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 180 days before the expiry of the date of this consent renewal letter.

The application shall be made in prescribed application form with consent renewal fee along with report of compliance of consent conditions mentioned in original consent letter and its subsequent consent renewal letter.


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



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
