





With reference to your above subject consent to operate is hereby granted for one year from the first day of the month of commissioning of the industry subject to the fulfillment of the following terms and conditions.

This consent is valid for product and production capacity of:-

CHLOROSULPHONIC ACID	23, 400 TPA (Twenty Three thousand Four hundred tonnes per annum)

Note : The above products and production capacity includes the existing plant production capacity. The previous consent issued to industry under Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 vide letter No. 13093 dt. 14/12/90 shall be treated as cancelled after commissioning of the plant.

1. Industry shall maintain air pollution control equipment at all points of emission and shall ensure that these are always kept running and in good working order all the time.
2. Industry shall continuously monitor HCl, Cl₂ and SO₃ through online sensors and ensure that these are always kept running and in good working orders all the time.
3. Industry shall ensure that the ambient air quality at the boundary of the factory premises shall conform to the following limits:

a.	Suspended Particulate Matter	500	Microgram/Cubic Meter
b.	Sulphur Dioxide [SO ₂]	120	-"
c.	Nitrogen Oxides [Nox]	120	-"
d.	Carbon Monoxide [CO]	5000	-"


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4. Industry shall submit six-monthly ambient air quality monitoring reports to the Board regularly. Some of the guidelines in this regards are as below:-
 - [a] The sampling of ambient air quality shall be done on 8 hours basis.
 - [b] The monitoring of ambient air quality shall be done atleast at four stations.
5. Industry shall submit environmental statement for the previous year ending 31st March on or before 30th September every year to the Board.
6. Industry shall ensure fully compliance of all the recommendations made in Nagda-Ratlam Action Plan by CPCB vide their letter No. B-29012/23/93/PCI-I/9079, dated: 04/06/98.
7. The industry shall take suitable measures to control the noise pollution. The noise level shall not exceed the limit 75dB[A] during the day time and 70-dB[A] during the night time.
8. Industry shall take adequate precautionary measures before and during operation, maintenance and cleaning of pollution control equipment to avoid accidental hazard. Industry shall comply all the conditions imposed by Health & Safety Department.
9. The industry shall establish an Environment Management Cell to carry out function relating to environmental management.
10. The industry shall do extensive tree plantation in and around the factory premises for improvement of the environment in general in consultation with the expert agency and good house keeping practices shall be adopted. All the internal roads shall be made pucca.
11. Any change in product, production capacity, process, raw materials used etc. shall be intimated to the Board. For any enhancement of the above prior permission of the Board shall be obtained.
12. Board reserves the right to amend/cancel the consent or any of the above conditions in part or as a whole as and when deemed necessary.

This consent is valid for the stated period and has to be renewed evert year. Application with annual license fee in this regard shall reach this office 180 days before the expiry of this consent.




