**Notice inviting Expressions of Interest (EoI) for conducting Environmental Studies
of Singrauli District Madhya Pradesh**

1. Background:

Singrauli District of Madhya Pradesh spreads in an area of about 5,672 Km². The district possesses abundant natural resources especially the coal deposits which feed major industries across the country. Most of the regions where mineral and mineral based industries and other allied industries are located are subjected to high pollution load. Singrauli in Madhya Pradesh is one such region, where a number of mineral based industries including thermal power stations are located and which is highly affected by the coal mining, allied operations and emissions from diversified industries. In this region the problems may be many folds. Mining operations & allied activities, the urban settlements and colonies are in close proximity to each other resulting in a growth pattern, which is mutually incompatible and environmentally unsustainable. The above activities are also disposing their waste material in haphazard manner. This has resulted in high level of pollution, degraded land and choked and polluted streams. Some part of Singrauli has been declared as 'problem area' by the Central Pollution Control Board, with Comprehensive Environmental Pollution Index (CEPI) of 81.73.

Government of Madhya Pradesh (Housing & Environment Department) and Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board have decided to carry out a Rapid Environmental Study of the region so as to identify the land parcels within the district suitable for further industrialization.

2. Scope of Work:

The task shall include survey of existing industries specially the compliance of conditions imposed by Regulatory Authorities through their clearances. The environmental study of the region would further include the Environmental monitoring & modeling followed by the application of spatial planning tools. Environmental Management Plan and industry-siting guidelines shall also be formulated using the above studies so as to improve environmental quality.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

The consultant institutions including Academic Institutions, Autonomous Bodies and other reputed organizations should fulfill the following criteria:

- (a) Organizations/institutions should be accredited by MoEF, CPCB or QCI
- (b) Adequate knowledge, experience of work in a similar field in India or abroad.
- (c) Adequate manpower in the fields of Environmental Science and Engineering, Environmental Management and related field.

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4. Submission of EOI:

Interested Organization / Institutions fulfilling the above criteria may submit EOI in a sealed envelope by speed post clearly superscripted as 'Expressions of Interest (EOI) for conducting Environmental Studies of Singrauli District Madhya Pradesh' to the Member Secretary, M. P. Pollution Control Board E-5, Arera Colony Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal (M.P) by 20 December 2010, in two hard copies and a CD containing the following information in a maximum of 5 'A-4' Pages (excluding curriculum vitae and attachments) and a font size of 12:-

- (a) Type of organization and date of establishment with photocopies of supporting documents.
 - (b) Areas of strength/specialization relevant to the scope of work, as mentioned under para 2 of this document.
 - (c) Copies of the accreditation certificate as provided by the MoEF/QCI/CPCB
 - (d) Previous relevant experience.
 - (e) Details of key staff to be entrusted for the assignment, together with their curriculum vitae.
 - (f) Undertaking of the scope of work, short approach and comments.
5. Late submissions or submissions that do not conform to the above requirements will not be considered.
 6. Interested Institutions including Academic Institutions, Autonomous Bodies and other reputed Organizations are also required to state any involvement or interest that may have direct or indirect conflict with the duties to be performed for this consultancy. In case the consultant's involvement or his interest in the project is discovered later on, the agreement will be cancelled.
 7. Based on the response received, suitable consultants will be listed and the TOR document will be sent for entering into agreement.
