NATIONAL RIVER CONSERVATION PLAN [9th Plan]

Brief Note

1. Ministry of Environment & Forests launched Ganga Cleaning Project in 1986. Ministry formed National River Conservation Directorate (NRCD) for abatement of pollution of river waters. The schemes under National River Conservation Plan (NRCP) are aimed at supplementing the existing sanitation improvement programmes of the towns situated on the bank of major rivers and are not to substitute functions of local bodies.

2. In Madhya Pradesh 11 towns situated along the bank of 7 rivers were included under National River Conservation Plan. Under this plan DPR`s costing Rs. 101.19 Cores were prepared under 100 % Centrally funded schemes and submitted to National River conservation Directorate (NRCD) as mentioned below:

3. The operation and maintenance of the works executed under the scheme is the responsibility of State Government through respective local bodies. Out of the 76 DPRs of various sub-project submitted to NRCD, 58 DPRs costing Rs. 75.32 Crores were sanctioned.

Out of these 58 schemes, 55 have been completed and remaining 03 schemes are under progress. Allocation of Rs. 70 Crores

received from Govt. of India so far and Rs. 69.22 Crores (as on July 2007) have been spent on various schemes.

4. The nature of the works included under above plan was:-

- (a) Interception and Diversion (I&D) of Nallas draining into rivers.
- (b) Acquisition of land for sewage treatment.
- (c) Construction of Sewage treatment plant (STP).
- (d) Construction of improved Crematoria.
- (e) Low cost sanitation (Construction of Sulabh Complexes in catchment area)
- (f) River Front Development (RFD) i.e. Construction of Ghats to protect River Front
- (g) Afforestation (plantation) in catchment area.
