Above committee as per provisions of the rules appended,shall identify and recommend to the State Government for grant of awards the names of such eligible industries/mines/urban bodies of the State where performance in one year has been excellent in the matter of environment and pollution control.

Particulars of eligible industry/mines/urban bodies and the amount of award is as follows:-

The State Government, hereby makes following rules to be followed by such of the industries/ mines/urban bodies in the State, as may wish to have their case considered for securing one such award under any of category mentioned above,namely :-

RULES

1. **Short Title** :- These rules may be called the Madhya Pradesh Annual Award for the best performance of Industrial Unit/ Mines/ Urban Bodies for Environment and Pollution Control Rules,2015;
2. **Definitions** :- In these rules unless the context otherwise requires –
 - (a) "Board" means the Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board, a State Board constituted under Section 4 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974;
 - (b) "Committee" means the person or persons as the State Government may appoint for considering the Claims of the industries and recommend the names of such industries which in their opinion are most suitable for the grant of annual award under each category;
 - (c) "Highly Polluting Industry" means an industry established in Madhya Pradesh and mentioned in Annexure-1 and having a capital investment as decided by Industry Department on plant and machinery;
 - (d) "General Industry" means the industries established in Madhya Pradesh but other than those categorized under highly polluting and having a capital investment as decided by Industry Department ;

- (e) "Small Scale Industry" means the industry located in the State and covered under any of the category as mentioned in Annexure-1, and having a capital investment as decided by Industry Department ;
- (f) "Municipal Corporation" means the Corporation established in the State of Madhya Pradesh and categorized under Urban Development Department;
- (g) "Municipality / Nagar Parishad" means the Municipality established in Madhya Pradesh and categorized under Urban Development Department;
- (h) "Active Mines" means the pits whether open or under ground from where minerals are being extracted;
- (i) "Form" means a form specified in Annexure-II.
3. The industries/mines/ urban bodies desires to be considered for the annual award, shall submit their claims in the prescribed manner, supporting enclosures to the Board by 30th April of each year stating the position as on 31st March of that year.
4. Only such industries/mines/urban bodies shall be eligible to pply for the award which possess the letter of consent/renewal for the current period, issued under the water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the letter of authorization under Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2008/ Municipal Solid Wastes (Management & Handling) Rules, 1999 .
5. All claims received on or before the prescribed date by the Board, shall be placed before the committee. The committee shall scrutinize and adjudge the claims received and recommend the name or names of the industry/ Mines/ urban bodies to which the award should be given by the State Government. In case the committee has no names to suggest, a recommendation to that effect shall be made. In case the committee recommends more than one name but limited to two, then the amount of award shall be distributed equally amongst them.
6. The committee shall follow its own procedure for conduct of business but shall make the recommendation to the State Government for sanction not later than 31st March of the each financial year.
7. The recommendations made by the committee shall be final.

8. The State Government may amend the rule or annexure under these rules and such amendments shall be effective from the date on which they are made.
9. The State Government shall take a final decision on the recommendation of the committee for conferring the awards.
10. The award mentioned in annexure-II shall be given to the Industry/ Mines/ Urban Bodies concerned by the Government along with cash award.
